

Questions to Ask Candidates

1. Are you related to any Rotary member? [Candidates cannot be Rotarians, Honorary Rotarians, or employees of a club, district, or other Rotary entity or of Rotary International. Spouses, lineal descendants (child or grandchild by blood or legal adoption), spouses of lineal descendants, and ancestors (parent or grandparent by blood) of persons in the foregoing categories are also ineligible. Please note that Rotarians and their relatives remain ineligible for scholarship awards for 36 months after a Rotarian has resigned from club membership.]
2. Please give a brief biography of yourself and why you are applying for this scholarship, as opposed to other scholarships.
3. Where do you see yourself in ten years?
4. Can you describe your service-related experiences?
5. What books have you read recently? If you had to name one book that has deeply influenced your life, what would it be and why?
6. Have you applied for any other scholarships?
7. If you do not receive this scholarship, what are your plans?
8. Do you have any questions of the committee?
